The rough draft is due on Thursday, and the final draft will be due with an illustration on Friday.




#### Ideas:

- 1) actor/actress, which actor/actress would they be and why?
- 2) on a football team, which positions would they play and why?
- 3) book or movie, which genres of book or movie would they be and why?
- 4) car, which type of car would they be and why?
- 5) singer, which singer would they be and why?
- 6) artist, which artist would they be and why?
- 7) Any other analogy that you may come up with that I approve

## Outline/Examples for writing descriptions:

**The example analogy compares the early Europeans to types of vehicles.**

- I. What are the Spanish compared to?
  - a. Compare the Spanish settlers to something (i.e. The Spanish were like a bulldozer).
  - b. Include examples from your notes (i.e. "The Spanish would be like bulldozer because they ran over the Native Americans when they arrived kind of like a bulldozer pushes over piles of dirt during construction.").
  - c. Conclusion: Restate your comparison and give a closing statement.
  
- II. What are the French compared to?
  - a. Compare the French settlers to something (i.e. The French were like a Prius).
  - b. Include examples from your notes (i.e. "The French would be like a Prius because they are friendly to the environment like the French were friendly to the Natives").
  - c. Conclusion: Restate your comparison and give a closing statement.
  
- III. What are the English compared to?
  - a. Compare the English settlers to something (i.e. The English were like a Mustang).
  - b. Include examples from your notes (i.e. "The English would be like a Mustang because they are very nice on the outside and everyone likes them upon first impression, but they are bad for the environment because they burn so much gas. This is like the English because on the outside they were nice to the Natives, but when the moment came they didn't care about them or their land").
  - c. Conclusion: Restate your comparison and give a closing statement.
