- C. Why might someone disagree with your opinion? Be specific about what a person might say when trying to counter your opinion.
- D. Good Thesis Statements contain words like
 - Because
 - Unless
 - Although
 - Even though
 - Since
 - However

Examples of thesis sentence structures	Example of a thesis sentence
<p>Even though C, A because of B1 and B2</p> <p>A since B1, B2, and B3, however C</p> <p>Although C, A because of B1, B2, and B3.</p> <p>A because of B1, B2, B3, unless C.</p>	<p>The Europeans misunderstood the Native Americans during colonization and as a result the (My opinion/argument)</p> <p>Europeans forced the Natives into slavery, (Social support point)</p> <p>destroyed their system of tribes and empires, and (Political support point)</p> <p>took control of their raw resources and goods. (Economic support point)</p> <p>However, they did increase the amount of food and medicine available to Native Americans. (Counter opinion)</p>

There are many ways to piece together a thesis statement and the type of question can change how you should format the sentence, however, all of the above parts should be included.
